## Interactive Gig Experience



In essence, up-market '**live band**' karaoke.

A song list is given to audience members, they volunteer and the band calls them up to sing at an appropriate time during the gig.

This can be extended to include voting, panel of judges and a presenter

Group is divided into teams - ideally 5-8 people.

Teams are given a song to sing with the live band and are told they will be performing later that day.



With assistance from a relevant coach, teams learn a song, assign lead singers/backing vocalists/ dancers, choreograph some dance moves and decide on costumes.

Teams get a 20 minute rehearsal with live band. They are coached on some basic vocal and microphone techniques as well as performance tips (basic essentials as time is limited). This section is fast-paced and exciting with animated interaction from the coaches and the band.

Performance takes place. A TV-style presenter directs the proceedings, TV set provided (dependent on budget), a panel of judges is selected from key company personalities. The overall activity is high-energy, adrenalin-fuelled and very competitive between teams (but in a friendly way!).

Voting takes place, winning team takes the stage for a victory rendition.



The **band** then plays a set or two and everyone parties. During this period there are further opportunities for attendees to sing with band (*see Interactive Gig Experience above*).

## Notes

### Time scale

**Interactive Gig Experience:** This activity takes place within the time frame of a regular gig, usually a three hour duration.

**Team Building Experience:** Usually starts after lunch with group coaching. Followed by band rehearsals approx 16:00 – 19:00 hrs. Performance takes place through dinner, either in stages (i.e. two groups after each course) or in one block, back to back after dinner (approx one hour running time).

### Production

**Low Budget** – basic pa & lighting/stage set. **High Budget** – sophisticated stage layout, video screens, autocue on-stage (for lyrics), presenter, panel of judges, pa & lighting etc.
